Wine By The Glass

Red

Masciarelli, Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2007, Italy: (6oz) Glass 11.25, ½Liter 29.95, Bottle 45.00

A medium bodied dry red wine with floral aromas, and flavours of cherry and brambly berries, with a smooth spiced finish.

Dolcetto D'Alba, Orlando Abrigo 2007, Italy: (6oz) Glass 11.25, ½Liter 29.95, Bottle 45.00

A classic wine of the Langhe hills, Dolcetto's intense ruby-red colour sparkles with mauve highlights, while its fragrant and flowery aromas feature cherries and violets, joined by ripe fruit and raisins after a year

Mission Hill Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2006: (6oz) Glass 11.25, ½Liter 29.95, Bottle 45.00

This full bodied red has aromas of rich blackberry with nicely balanced tannins and toasty oak, being aged in both American and French oak.

Merlot, Allegretto La Stella 2006: (6oz) Glass 12.95, ½Liter 34.95, Bottle 50.00

This is a medium bodied, medium tannins with currants, plum and dark berries dominating the palate, with a long, smooth and elegant.

Pinot Noir, Juveniles Pinot Noir 2008, Tantalus: (6oz) Glass 9.50, ½Liter 25.50, Bottle 38.00

This medium ruby red, has aromas and flavors fresh raspberry and spice, with note of vanilla and finishing off with sweet red fruits.

Gamay Noir, Blue Mountain 2008 : (6oz) Glass 9.95, ½Liter 26.95, Bottle 40.00

Juicy raspberry flavours, notes of blackcurrant and good acidity are complemented by a long, spicy finish.

Shiraz, Cassini Cellars 2008, Oliver : (6oz) Glass 9.50, ½Liter 25.50, Bottle 38.00

This medium ruby red, has aromas and flavors of dark cherry, fresh raspberry and spice, with a velvety lingering finish.

White

Pinot Grigio Principesco 2009, Italy: (6oz) Glass 8.95, ½Liter 24.95, Bottle 36.00

Light bodied and refreshing this dry white wine is delicate, accompanied by a crisp bouquet.

Pinot Noir Rosé, Sevenstones 2006: (6oz) Glass 9.50, ½Liter 25.50, Bottle 38.00

With heaps of strawberries on the nose with underlying tones of watermelon and violets. The palate is dry, spicy, with notes strawberry sorbet and some savory cardamom.

Pinot Gris 2008, Cassini Cellars: (6oz) Glass 8.95, ½Liter 24.95, Bottle 36.00

This dry white aged in oak, has flavours of ripe pear and citrus with a crisp clean finish.

Sevenstones, Chardonnay 2005: (6oz) Glass 9.95, ½Liter 26.95, Bottle 40.00

This wine shows toasty and white peach aromas. On the palate, the citrus flavours are supported by light toastiness. As the wine warms in the glass, tropical fruit flavours also emerge.

Sauvignon Blanc, Fairview Cellars 2006: Glass 9.95, ½Liter 26.95, Bottle 40.00

This medium bodied white has a very refreshing palate with aromas of crisp citrus and mineral and smooth zesty finish on the palate.

Ehrenfeller 2008, Summerhill Vineyard : (6oz) Glass 9.50, ½Liter 25.50, Bottle 38.00

A medium bodied well-balanced white wine, with hints of citrus and pear, resulting in a smooth wine.

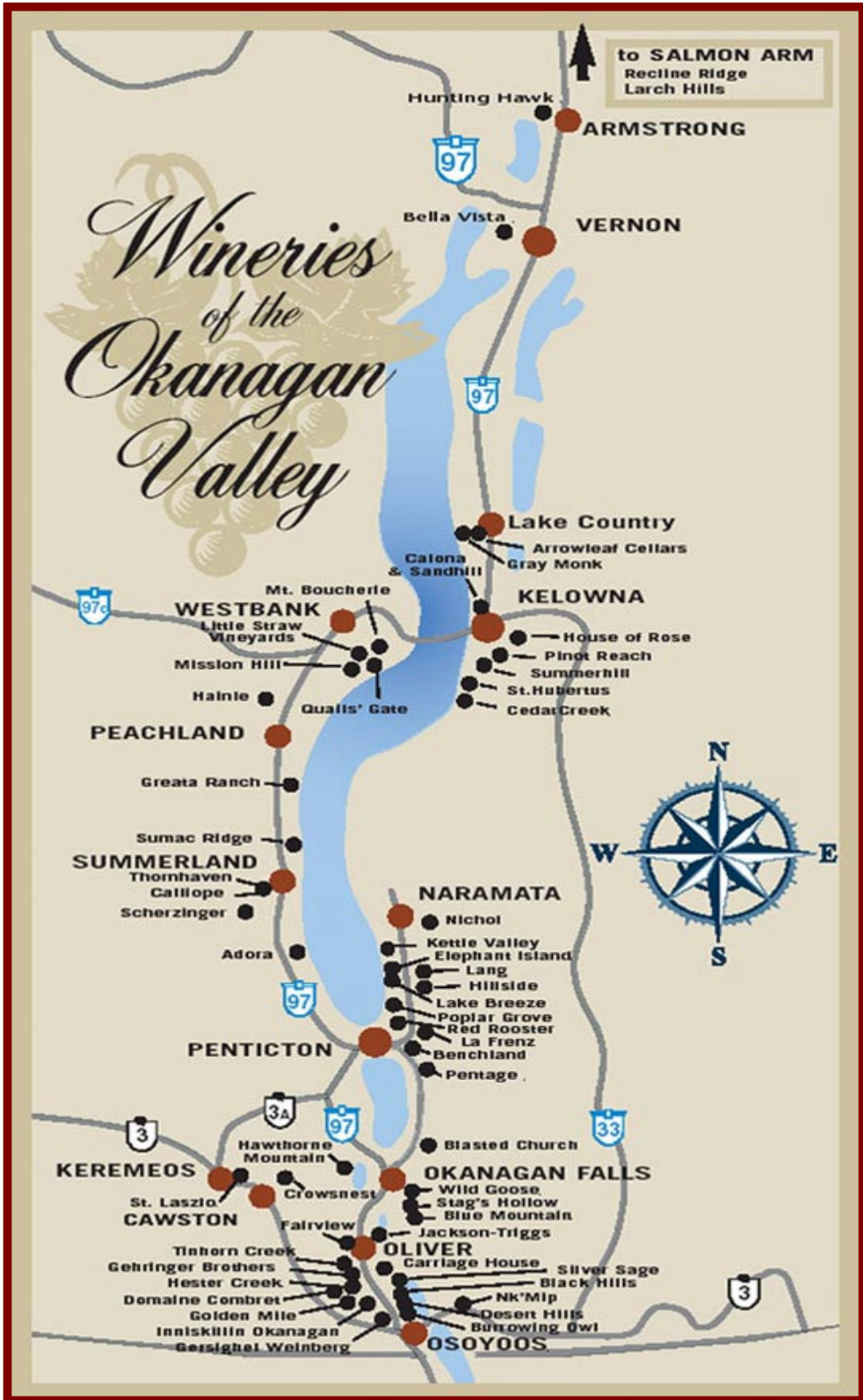

Barbaresco

Barbaresco is Barolo's near neighbor and stylistic soul mate. Barbaresco is also produced from Nebbiolo grapes, but tends to be softer and slightly more graceful. Less than half as much Barbaresco is made each year as Barolo. There are just three, small growing regions for Barbaresco compared to Barolo's eleven. Barbaresco, too, requires aging - a minimum of two years and up to twenty years - to meet its full potential. In general, Barbaresco is drinkable a little sooner than Barolo. It also pairs well with red meat and the rich food of Piedmont.

Chianti

Chianti is produced from primarily Sangiovese grapes, sometimes combined with a little Cabernet Franc, Merlot, or Cabernet Sauvignon. Chianti is subtle and less harsh than a Cabernet Sauvignon and more elegant than a Zinfandel or a Syrah. It has a high acidity and hints of plum and wild cherry. Chianti and any tomato-based sauce are a classic wine and food pairing, but Chianti also goes well with a steak or other grilled meat.

Made from air-dried, predominantly Corvina, grapes, Amarone is produced in the northern Veneto region near Venice, using the "recioto" method. Amarones are aged for five years or more before bottling. Some, but not all, are aged in oak barrels. Amarone is lush and complex and it has a powerful, concentrated, almost Port-like texture with hints of mocha. Amarone is ideal with meats and with cheeses.
