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Wine By The Glass

Red

Aglianico, Vesevo I.G.T., Beneventano, Italy: Glass 9.50, ½Liter 25.50, Bottle 38.00
This dark, velvety, jammy full-bodied red has flavors of plum and damsons on the nose, with hints of flowers and leather.

Rosso del Veronese, Masi Campofiorin , Italy: Glass 9.95, ½Liter 26.95, Bottle 40.00
Produced from predominantly Corvina grapes, this wine is full-bodied, with hints of sweet raisins, and a smooth finish.

Merlot, Sumac Ridge, Black Sage Vineyard: Glass 9.95, ½Liter 26.95, Bottle 40.00
Aged in small French oak barrels, this well-balanced wine has notes of plums and berry flavours.

Osoyoos La Rose, Pétales d'Osoyoos 2004: Glass 12.95, ½Liter 34.95, Bottle 50.00
This classic Bordeaux is a full-bodied blend of Merlot, Cab-Sau, Cab-Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot that displays aromas and velvety flavours of vanilla, raspberry, chocolate and spice.

Pinot Noir, Cedar Creek Estate Select 2005: Glass 11.25, ½Liter 29.95, Bottle 45.00
Medium Ruby red in colour with intense aromas of black cherry, fresh strawberries, cinnamon and cedar.

Sangiovese, Sandhill Small Lot Program 2004: Glass 12.95, ½Liter 34.95, Bottle 52.00
Aged for 16 monthss in French oak barrels, this wine has a medium garnet red colour, wwith flavors of cherry and plum aromas with a hint of spiciness.

Syrah, Hillside Estate 2005: Glass 12.95, ½Liter 34.95, Bottle 50.00
A robust full-bodied cool climate syrah, with characateristics of blackberry and rhubarb with a hint of spiciness.

White

Pinot Grigio, Italy: Glass 8.95, ½Liter 24.95, Bottle 36.00
Light bodied and refreshing this dry white wine is delicate, accompanied by a crisp bouquet.

Chardonnay, Serafino, McLaren Vale, Australia: Glass 9.95, ½Liter 26.95, Bottle 40.00
This unwooded chardonnay, is fresh and fruit driven, with tropical fruits and flavours.

Pinot Gris, Blue Mountain Vineyard: Glass 9.95, ½Liter 26.95, Bottle 40.00
A rich finish follows sweet fruit and orange peel on the nose and palate.

Mission Hill Reserve, Chardonnay: Glass 9.95, ½Liter 24.95, Bottle 37.00
Tropical pineapple, sweet citrus, and pear combined with light oak notes, give this an elegant and balanced finish.

Gewurztraminer, Quails' Gate Vineyard: Glass 8.95, ½Liter 24.95, Bottle 36.00
A fruit driven white, showing notes of cinnamon, spice, pink grapefruit and hints of pear.

Ehrenfelser, Summerhill Vineyard : Glass 9.50, ½Liter 25.50, Bottle 38.00
A medium bodied well-balanced white wine, with hints of citrus and pear, resulting in a smooth wine.

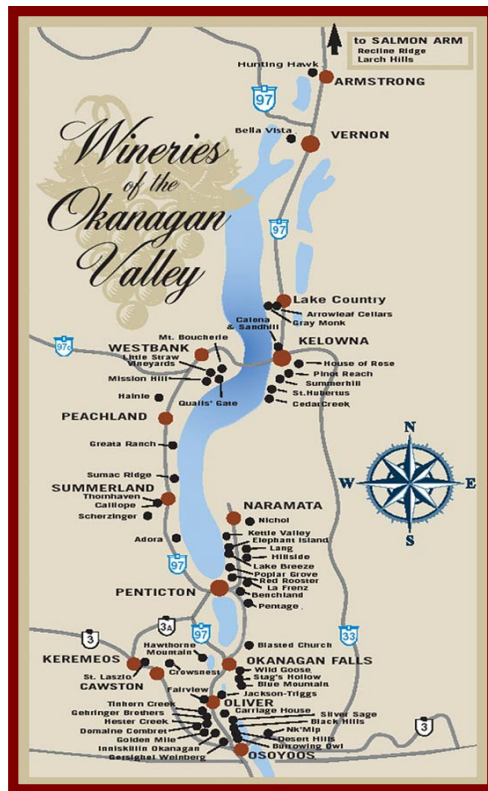

Barbaresco

Barbaresco is Barolo's near neighbor and stylistic soul mate. Barbaresco is also produced from Nebbiolo grapes, but tends to be softer and slightly more graceful. Less than half as much Barbaresco is made each year as Barolo. There are just three, small growing regions for Barbaresco compared to Barolo's eleven.

Barbaresco, too, requires aging - a minimum of two years and up to twenty years - to meet its full potential. In general, Barbaresco is drinkable a little sooner than Barolo. It also pairs well with red meat and the rich food of Piedmont.

Chianti

Chianti is produced from primarily Sangiovese grapes, sometimes combined with a little Cabernet Franc, Merlot, or Cabernet Sauvignon. Chianti is subtle and less harsh than a Cabernet Sauvignon and more elegant than a Zinfandel or a Syrah. It has a high acidity and hints of plum and wild cherry. Chianti and any tomato-based sauce are a classic wine and food pairing, but Chianti also goes well with a steak or other grilled meat.

Made from air-dried, predominantly Corvina, grapes, Amarone is produced in the northern Veneto region near Venice, using the "recioto" method. Amarones are aged for five years or more before bottling. Some, but not all, are aged in oak barrels. Amarone is lush and complex and it has a powerful, concentrated, almost Port-like texture with hints of mocha. Amarone is ideal with meats and with cheeses.
